Kindergarten students have Spanish every Monday and Thursday from 10:15- 10:30. Classes are taught by Señora Leuschner with the help of her three friends: Señor Frio, Señora Zanahorias and Señorita Loca por Nueces.

So far the students have learned how to say hello to adults and friends. In October and November the students will learn:

1. How to ask someone his name. (¿Cómo te llamas?)
2. How to say, “My name is....” (Me llamo)
3. How to say, “His/ Her name is....” (Se llama....)
4. Two ways to ask, “How are you?” (¿Cómo estás? and ¿Cómo está usted?)
5. Five different ways to say how they feel (muy bien, bien, regular, así así and mal)

Later in the year we will also study:

1. How to say how old they are.
2. colors
4. numbers (1-10)
5. animals
6. Sounds of the Spanish
