

Sixth Grade Social Studies - Second Marking Period, 2011

The sixth grade has studied ancient Mesopotamia, Egypt, India and China. The following are examples of activities that have been worked on during this marking period:

- Students wrote jokes in hieroglyphics
- researched the mummification process
- learned about the Egyptian gods and their fascination with the afterlife
- compared the ancient Olmecs to the ancient Mayans
- predicted their future with oracle bones

During the third marking period, the sixth graders will learn about the origins of the different religions of the world and ancient Greece and Rome.
