

## Sixth and Seventh Grade Social Studies

The sixth and seventh grades just concluded an intense study of the US Constitution. They illustrated the Bill of Rights and sang a Schoolhouse Rock song that detailed the Preamble to the Constitution. Mrs. Cody required that they memorize the preamble for her Language Arts class. We have begun to learn about the first government of the US.



The eighth graders worked on a differentiated instruction unit on the North and the South during the early 1800's. Students were able to choose projects about the north and south that suited their interest and aptitude. The events leading to the Civil War are being studied in December with a study of the Civil War after the holidays.



All 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders are responsible for two current events reports each marking period. Each report must have three paragraphs, an analysis of the report, and a technological representation of the event. Sixth graders are required to report on a current event with four well written paragraphs.
